Four athletes from our U9/10 age group were super excited to get their event underway.

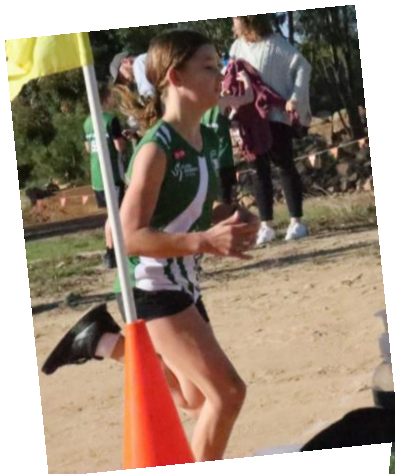
